

Members of Major William A. McTeer Camp 39 met at Calhoun's, Maryville, for the monthly McTeer Camp Mess at 1230 hours on Tuesday, 9 Aug 2016.

1. CC David McReynolds called the meeting to order at 1230 hours. It was going to be a brief meeting because of the light schedule of activities. The purpose of the meeting was to review future events and to share information for the good of the order.
2. The Commander requested that the secretary sign a check for \$756.33 to pay for expenses associated with the ceremony on 24 July that honored the Sesquicentennial of the Readmission of Tennessee to the Union.
3. The Commander identified Ken Cornett as a likely applicant for membership. Mr. Cornett is a leader in local history organizations and events.
4. The Commander reminded the Brothers that the Camp would man their tent at the East Tennessee History Fair and First Families of Tennessee Reunion on 19 August at Krutch Park on Gay Street, Knoxville.
5. Secretary/Treasurer Doug Fidler reported that the Camp treasury had deposits totaling \$2,040.06. This was reduced by \$756.33 (see Item 2) for the Readmission Ceremony and \$100 paid to Gena Tussey, the event photographer. This reduced the balance to \$1,183.73.

Secretary Fidler gave a brief summary of the many events of the dedication of the Ensign John Davis headstone, the presentation of the Davis Camp Charter by Commander-in-Chief Gene Mortorff, the initial meeting of the Camp and the election of officers, and a Chinway that included Davis Brothers, family members and other interested participants. It occurred in London, England.
7. CC McReynolds closed the meeting at 1330 hours.
